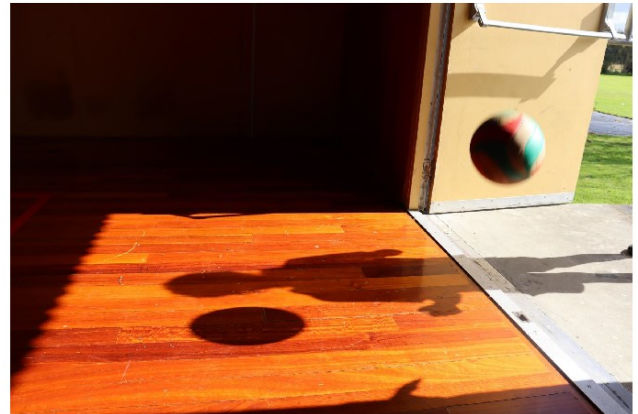
Kahukura Kawhata-Morgan Yr 6

There were the most photos ever entered this year with over 140 entries. So having 3 finalists from Mangakahia was impressive.

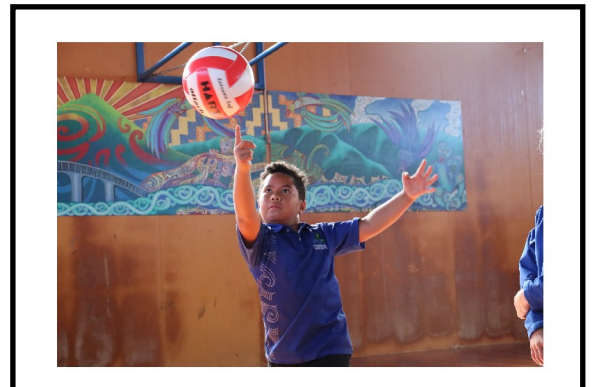
